5. Exhibitor must grow all entries.
6. Judges may award an "Honorable Mention" ribbon at their discretion.
7. Exhibits in the Specimen Flowers division must be cut flowers grown by the exhibitor and must conform to the number of blooms, spikes or stems as specified in each class.
8. Exhibits in the Specimen Flowers division must be of one color and variety (unless otherwise stated) and in a totally clear glass container (no colorations or designs on glass).
9. Exhibits by professional florists are not permitted.
10. Rose entries shall be one stem, one bloom (no unopened buds), and one set of leaves. Healthy leaves are an important factor in rose entries.
