Dept. 006, Dairy Goats and Dept. 010, 4-H Dairy Goats

All exhibitors must submit proper <u>Veterinary Inspection and Veterinarian Relationship</u> documentation before unloading show animals.

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"Health Papers" (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection or CVI) issued after May 1 are recommended and can be presented upon arrival at the Fair, or can be mailed in prior to the Fair to expedite check-in. All animals must be freeof infectious and contagious diseases, and a statement of this should be written on the CVI.

The following Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinary Consultation Relationship statement for the animals being exhibited is included with a signature line on the Entry Form: "I attest and affirm that a "veterinary consultation relationship" - as that phrase is defined in the Animal Exhibition Sanitation Law found at 3 Pa.C.S.A. § 2501 et seq. and any amendments thereto - exists with regard to any animals I will be exhibiting."Include the Name and Phone Number of the Consulting Veterinarian. Animals entering with a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) are exempt from this statement requirement. Parent/Guardian signature is required if the owner/caretaker is under 18 years of age. Refer to General Livestock Health Regulations (page 11) as well as the breed-specific rules in this catalog.
